Low Pressure Sewer System

Sterling Park Stage 4

As part of our Subdivision Consent, the Selwyn District Council require the installation of a low pressure sewer system for lots **3 to 21**. Note, Lots 1 & 2 are to be connected for sewer by conventional gravity sewer.

When your home is being built, the pump system will be installed with the rest of your house's plumbing & drainage works and at your cost. Please see the **"Overview of E/One Grinder Pump System"** for full details of the installation requirements. **Please ensure your builder, drainage contractor and electrical contractor are provided with this information**.

Of particular note:

- Ecoflow Ltd will provide a special Sterling Park price of \$5805+GST provided you purchase the pump directly off them. If you prefer to install a different pump, this would have to be approved by Selwyn District Council.

- On your street frontage you will find the boundary kit toby box with a black lid. This is the connection point for the pump's discharge line into the Council sewer network.
- Ecoflow are required to carry out a final inspection (included in their price). Please ensure your installer has completed the "Prior to Inspection" checklist (see Page 6 of the overview) before the Ecoflow technician commissions the pump. The commissioning inspection needs to occur prior to wastewater entering the tank. Ecoflow will then notify the Selwyn District Council that the system is operational.
- The pump system will be maintained by you.
- Please refer to the **"Overview of E/One Grinder Pump System"** for important information on what should not be flushed or discharged into the Selwyn District Council's sewer network.
